



- ▶ 4 other full year subject choices


To consider:


Online Subject Selection

The Counselling day

- ▶ Appointment is made with a 'Counselling Team'
 - ▶ Discussion about SACE, achievement so far (recommendations), future pathways
 - ▶ Review subjects selected on-line
 - ▶ Edit or Approve
 - ▶ Print and sign – parent / student / counsellor
 - ▶ VET pathway options should be discussed with Penny Chancellor

Booking an Appointment

- ▶ Where possible each meeting will involve parents, the student and two counselling staff
 - ▶ Students who are currently studying a VET pathway or are considering a VET pathway should book a meeting with Penny Chancellor
 - ▶ Students who are looking to gain an ATAR and follow a University pathway are most welcome to book a meeting with Tracy Warner or other listed staff

What happens now?

- ▶ Subject selections are made at all year levels
 - ▶ Timetable is generated, based on these choices
all students' choices are used to generate the school timetable, classes are created
 - ▶ subjects are cut if too few students select them,
clashes happen based on what subjects appear on
a line together
students and parents are consulted to reselect
when required
 - ▶ The final timetable is generated with fixed
subjects on lines, students are given timetables
